## Clinical negligence: facts and figures

During the past three financial years the number of new clinical and non-clinical

claims reported has fallen since peaking in 2013/14.



In 2016-17, the NHS received 208,415 written complaints,

the equivalent of 4,008 written complaints a week or 571 complaints per day.





Full-time GPs are now twice as likely to receive a claim for 👆 clinical negligence as they were a decade ago.



In 2016-17, the NHS made clinical negligence payments of £1,707.2 million.



In 2016, the General Medical Council received 8,197 complaints,

of which 18% were investigated, 6% were sent for further examination and 76% were closed immediately.



A 2013 report found it took more than a year for one in five people to be diagnosed with bowel cancer after first visiting their GP.
